Together, we walked alongside them—within congregations that opened their doors and on our campus—while our dedicated staff helped each guest pursue their goals for the future.

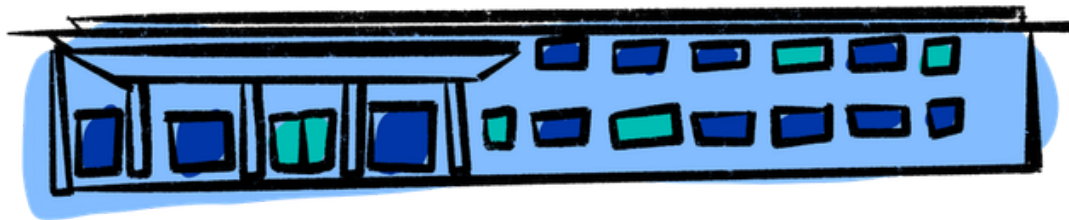
Your generosity made this possible: your financial gifts and countless volunteer hours created safety, stability, and hope.

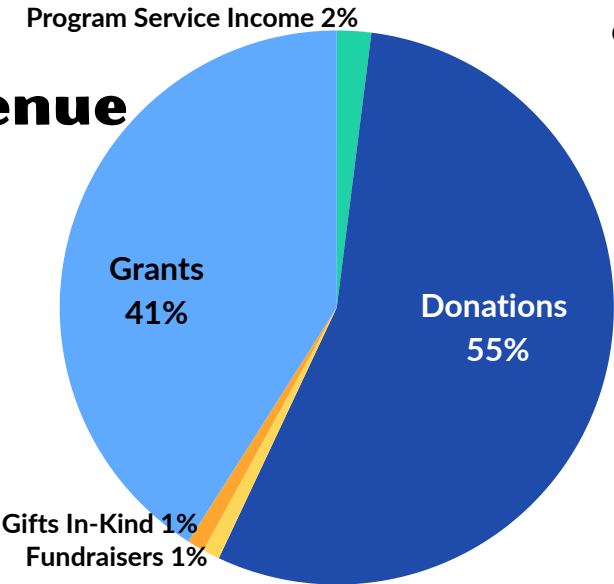

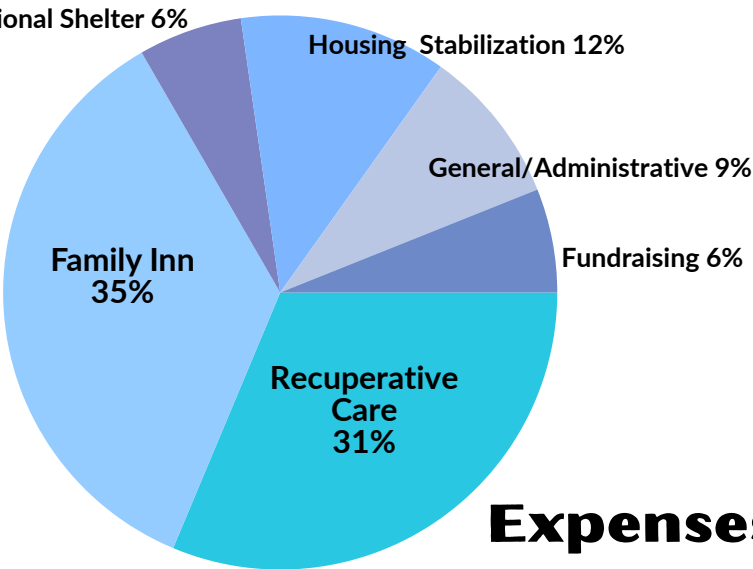

REMEMBERING GWEN



It's been fourteen years since we first shared Gwen's story. The end of her life was the beginning of what would become Room in the Inn - Memphis. It's because of Gwen, and the thousands of unique guests we have met since, that we continue making room in Memphis for those experiencing homelessness.

Rev. Lisa Anderson and the congregation she pastored had started sheltering guests in 2009. Lisa remembers, "The first time I saw Gwen she walked into our church with the group, quietly, bundled up, carrying a book in her hand. She found a church pew away from the noise of introductions and greetings. I went over and introduced myself as the pastor of the church, and Gwen stood up and threw her arms around me and said, **'I've been praying for you.'**

I sat with her the few minutes before dinner, and she showed me her Bible and a couple of scripture cards she had tucked inside. I said that it looked like her Bible was well used and she said, 'It's my only map.'

Her life was a testament to the reality of God's grace and mercy in life no matter where that map leads. Her faith lit up her face no matter how difficult the day had been. Her deep thankfulness for even the smallest gestures taught us that life's blessings are a gift we should not take for granted. The many volunteers at Room in the Inn came to love her gentle spirit and to count on her prayers for us as we also prayed for her. She was a witness to the transforming love of Christ."

When Room in the Inn's Congregational Shelter program ended with the winter season, Gwen - like many in Memphis - had no other options for free, safe shelter. On June 7th, 2012 she was found murdered on the steps of a church, where she had likely sought rest for the night.

We believe Gwen should not have died unsheltered and unsafe in our city - with hundreds of faith communities filled with buildings sitting empty each night and faithful people able to give a few hours to make a difference.

The number of shelter spaces in Memphis has not changed much since 2012, but the number of people (especially women and children) experiencing homelessness in our city has increased drastically.

Gwen's story and the stories of the many guests Room in the Inn has served since her death are a daily challenge to keep responding to this growing need. In 2021, we opened the Family Inn and Recuperative Care Center. In 2024 we committed to an annual summer season for our Congregational Nightly Shelter. We continue to need more faith communities and volunteers to host this program and give life-saving shelter to women, children and men who are vulnerable. Just as they are vulnerable to the harshness of the streets, they are also vulnerable to the love of God's people.
